Important notes about semester exams:

- Students may be exempt from the exam in a class if they have an A semester average for the class and 3 or less absences, or a B semester average for the class and 2 or less absences.
- All students must report to their 2nd period class at 9:00 am on Thursday, and their 6th period class at 9:00 am on Friday.
- If a student does not show up for 2nd/6th attendance, he/she will lose all of their exemptions for that day. (Attendance Period is mandatory for everyone)
- If the student is exempt from all exams that day, they are free to leave campus at 9:15.
- Students remaining on campus for exams after 9:15 will be required to go to their regularly scheduled classrooms whether they are exempt from their exams or not.
- Testing classrooms cannot be interrupted to sign students out.
- If the student has their own transportation (personal vehicle, parent pick-up) they may leave campus in-between exam times. For example: If a student needs to take a 2nd period and 4th period exam only on Thursday, they may leave at 9:15 and come back by 10:18 for their 2nd period exam then leave again at 11:22 and come back at 12:26 for 4th period exam. It is the student's responsibility to be back on campus at the appropriate time.
- Students will not be allowed to leave campus on foot to walk to Sonic, etc.
- No exams can be given early. Students must make arrangements to take final exams after the assigned testing days.
- On testing days, students are prohibited from being on any other school campus.
